On May 25-27 of 2017 a historic NATO Summit opened with conglomerating of new expectations and visions of the Alliance in volatile international order and current international relations conditions and with involvement of newly elected USA President Donald Trump with his extraordinary approaches toward actual problems of international security, including NATO's future missions and ob-

And many of these nations owe massive amounts of money from past years and not paying in those past years. Over the last eight years, the United States spent more in defense than all other NATO countries combined". He also echoed that if the other nations meet their fi-

nancial commitment to NATO standards than the Alliance will be stronger and immune from recent threats and risks. This was first deliberate speech of the United States new leader to the Brussels Summit colleagues and his main message to NATO leadership. Unfortunately no further prolongation was put forward in cementing NATO-EU strategic partnership endorsed in Warsaw NATO Summit last year. As Donald Trump and Donald Tusk, European Council President, did not reach consensus on Russia's case and were not enthusiastic in further on strategic linkage. Despite of the matter,

the key issue were discussing in the Summit agenda, notable as threat were concluded in:

- International terrorism and preventing and destroying ISIS anywhere and with this standpoint NATO will join the international anti-ISIS coalition in Middle East with its military coalition capabilities, mainly with Air Force ones;

- Illegal Migration

 Russia's aggressiveness toward NATO and its military confrontation lines toward the Alliance

As general observation, the Summit remains some uncertainties toward NATO enlargement policy that is very essential and substantial issues for Georgia and Ukraine in promoting their Euro-Atlantic integration policies and membership agendas for at least internal public consumption and reinforcing their national security environment. It was also unclear whether is being promoted socalled "Black Sea Security Initiative" launched in Warsaw Summit that is also very relevant to Georgia's current security provisions. Hence, the Summit has only recast many unwished feelings and remained to have quite nit so high expect-

Distinguished guests of the foundation were: conductor, composer and pianist Ezio Bosso, soprano Carmen Giannattasio and pianist Oliver Poole. The orchestra of the Opera House participated in the concert, conducted by maestro Bosso. In 2016, Bosso, one of the biggest musicians in the contemporary world, was recognized in Italy as the most active and successful musician at whose concert over 100 thousand tickets were sold. In Lon-

#### U.S. STATE DEPARTMENT DEL-EGATION HOLDS MEETINGS IN **GEORGIA**

Georgian Prime Minister Giorgi Kvirikashvili met with the U.S. delegation led by Deputy Assistant Secretary of State for European and Eurasian Affairs, Bridget Brink on May 24. Foreign Minister Mikheil Janelidze and Prime Minister's Foreign Adviser, Tedo Japaridze also attended the meeting.

The sides discussed a wide range of issues, among them the U.S.-Georgia Charter on Strategic Partnership, the U.S. assistance to Georgia, reforms, the country's European and Euro-Atlantic integration and PM Kvirikashvili's recent visit to

Earlier, on May 23, Deputy Assistant Secretary Brink and the U.S. delegation held the tenth meeting of the U.S.-Georgia Strategic Partnership Commission's Democracy and Governance Working Group. The Georgian side was represented by Deputy Foreign Minister, David Zalkaliani and First Deputy Justice Minister, Alexander Baramidze; representatives of various branches of government, including the parliamentary majority and minority groups also participated.

According to Zalkaliani, "the U.S. side reiterated that deepening strategic partnership with Georgia remains a priority of the U.S. foreign policy.'

During the meeting with Georgian Defense Minister Levan Izoria on May 25, Deputy Assistant Secretary Brink discussed Georgia Defense Readiness Program (GDRP) and the establishment of a combat training center in Georgia, as well as the plans for implementing the Substantial NATO-Georgia Package initiatives. Brink reiterated the U.S. support for Georgia's NATO membership bid. U.S. Ambassador to Georgia, Ian Kelly also attended the meeting.

President Giorgi Margvelashvili, who met with Bridget Brink and the U.S. delegation on May 24, thanked the United States for its support of Georgia's territorial integrity and sovereignty. calling the United States "number one strategic partner of Geor-

The U.S. delegation also held separate meetings in the Georgian Parliament with the opposition parties United National Movement (UNM) and Movement for Liberty - European Georgia: a number of issues, including amendments to the Georgian Constitution and election law were discussed.

UNM lawmaker, Nika Melia said that the participants discussed the issue of municipal elections set for October 2017, as well as the recent assault on the State Audit Office Chair. Otar Kakhidze of European Georgia said that the rule of law, iudicial independence and media pluralism in Georgia were discussed during the meeting with the U.S. delegation.

#### TURKISH PM MEETS GEORGIAN OFFICIALS IN TBILISI

Accompanied by seven ministers, Turkish Prime Minister Binali Yildirim paid one-day official visit to Georgia to attend the second meeting of the High Level Georgia-Turkey Strategic Cooperation



At a meeting with Prime Minister Giorgi Kvirikashvili, the two leaders spoke on Turkish-Georgian economic and political relations. They also touched upon the trilateral Georgia-Azerbaijan-Turkey cooperation format and focused on the implementation of the Baku-Tbilisi-Kars railway project.

According to the Georgian PM's office, the two Prime Ministers discussed joint transport and energy projects during the Strategic Cooperation Council meeting. Speaking on the Baku-Tbilisi-Kars railway project, PM Kvirikashvili noted that "the corridor will be one of the important segments of the revival of the great Silk Road

At the Council meeting, the sides signed various documents to foster bilateral cooperation in the fields of economy, justice, cybersecurity and culture.

At the joint press briefing after the Council, PM Kvirikashvili noted that his counterpart's visit to Georgia, as well as the existence of the Strategic Cooperation Council, "is a clear evidence of the well-defined will of the two countries' political leaders and of the spirit with which the bilateral relations are developing.

Kvirikashvili said that despite intensive economic exchanges between Georgia and Turkey, "untapped potential" needs to be fully realized. For that, Kvirikashvili went on, the sides signed the declaration on the establishment of the Joint Economic and Trade Commission (JETCO), "which is yet another step ahead in this respect."

The Prime Minister also stressed the importance of "widening the free trade agreement as much as possible," enabling Georgian producers to increase export volumes to Turkey.

In his remarks, as reported by the Georgian PM's press service, Prime Minister Binali Yildirim touched upon the economic relations as well, pledging to work on ensuring trade balance between Georgia and Turkey.

Following the High Level Strategic Cooperation Council meeting, Prime Minister Binali Yildirim met with President Giorgi Margvelashvili. According to the President's administration, the two discussed regional security challenges and NATO-Georgia rela-

"Turkey is Georgia's very active supporter in its Euro-Atlantic integration. The Warsaw Summit highlighted the Black Sea security challenges. And Turkey plays a very active role in the Black Sea security," President Margvelashvili stated.

On May 23, Foreign Minister Mevlut 3avusoglu, who accompanied Prime Minister Yildirim during his visit to Georgia, met with his Georgian counterpart, Mikheil Janelidze. The Georgian Foreign Ministry reported after the meeting that the sides spoke on a broad range of issues on bilateral, as well as multilateral agenda.

At the meeting, Minister Janelidze also expressed Tbilisi's gratitude for Turkey's unequivocal support for Georgia's sovereignty and territorial integrity, as well as for its Euro-Atlantic aspirations.

#### PM: HOLDING NATO PA SESSION IN TBILISI 'EXTREMELY IMPOR-TANT'

Georgian Prime Minister Giorgi Kvirikashvili said that holding the NATO Parliamentary Assembly Spring Session in Tbilisi "is extremely important.'

"It is very important that such a high level meeting will be held in a non-NATO member state. A declaration supporting Georgia's Euro-Atlantic integration will be adopted and we believe that holding such events in Georgia is extremely important for reiterating support to Georgia's foreign political course," PM Kvirikashvili said at the government's session on May 25.

Parliament's Defense and Security Committee Chair Irakli Sesiashvili, who also leads the Georgian Parliament's delegation to the NATO Parliamentary Assembly, also commented on the issue.

'The NATO Parliamentary Assembly has held its sessions in non-member states only four times in its history and Georgia will be the first country since 2002 to host the session. During the following four days Tbilisi, along with Brussels, will become NATO's political center that is a clear recognition of our country's democracy, progress, development, success," Sesiashvili said at a special press briefing on May 25.

He also said that about 600 delegates, among them lawmakers from 28 member states, observers from 20 non-member, associate and partner states will arrive in Georgia for the NATO PA session. As part of the visit, lawmakers from the NATO member states will visit South Ossetian administrative boundary line.

President Giorgi Margvelashvili, Prime Minister Giorgi Kvirikashvili and Parliamentary Chairman Irakli Kobakhidze will address the session on May 29.


