Vinotel wins Best Luxury Small Hotel in Eastern Europe Award

Luxury boutique hotel Vinotel recently won the Best Luxury Small Hotel in Eastern Europe Award at an annual award ceremony held in St. Moritz, Switzerland. The event was the 11th such ceremony celebrating the hospitality sector, organized by the British Organization World Luxury Hotels award, which brought together 2000 nominees from around 80 countries worldwide.

While the award category was determined by country, regional and global level, Vinotel was the only one to receive an international, regional award from Georgia. It won Best Luxury Small Hotel Award as a regional winner from Eastern Europe, in "recognition of a sustained commitment to excellence in hoteliering and outstanding achievement in the international luxury hospitality industry," - the award reads.

Already open three years, the hotel is located within a historic building which is a classic example of traditional Tbilisi architecture, in the old part of the capital city on the left embankment of the Mtkvari River at the gateway of the old Avlabari district.

Vinotel is frequented by numerous high-profile guests, artists, and international political and business figures.

There are 13 guest rooms and a restaurant with five separate chambers, each featuring a unique style, from the main hall, winetasting chamber with its oval oak bar table, and traditional chamber in an arched brick wine cellar, to a formal dining hall with a French fireplace for business dinners and a green terrace overlooked by an old church, another fine example of the hotel's connection with history as it at the same time presents all modern comforts.

The main therapeutic factor of resort Tskaltubo is radon mineral water. It is a non-seasonal resort and is open for 365 days throughout the entire year with no holidays.

Mineral water debit ranges from 13-15 million liters per 24 hours (day-night) based on the seasons. The natural temperature of water (33-35°C) makes it possible to use it without pre-heating.



GT interviewed GM of Hotel Citrus Shalva Alaverdashvili

Can you tell us about your hotel: when and how did you decide to build it?

Hotel Citrus is in a newly-built nine storey building, in which a separate wing was designed as a hotel. Although the owner of the hotel had various other businesses, it became a new challenge for him and fulfilled his expectations.

Our sophisticated design and ideal location have attracted the attention of customers and won their trust since 2015. Today you can hardly find anyone who does not know about Citrus.

What are your priorities, and how does Citrus differ from other hotels?

Hotel Citrus mainly focuses on the business segment. Diplomats, embassy staff and businessmen feel secure here. Our central location and feeling of security are particularly important for our clients. The hotel’s sophisticated style and high level services make Citrus very special.

Though Citrus is only three years old it has gained great popularity. The hotel is completely non-smoking, which is welcomed by our guests. It is open to all nationalities and religions, and we always take into account our guests’ wishes and cultural needs.

What are your room prices for the various seasons and do you offer any discounts?

Our prices are the same throughout the year. We have not increased the prices of our services, and also offer discounts during the low seasons. We offer spe-



cial rates and corporate prices for our loyal partners. We also organize Thanksgiving Day during the low season, when we and our partners conduct a promotional lottery, with numerous prizes, to express our gratitude to our partners and invited guests.

What are the style/functionality of the rooms you offer?

We have 36 rooms, including standard, family rooms and studios, four rooms for persons with disabilities and semi-luxury and luxury suites. All are well furnished and include a working area, safe, individual climate controls and personal hygiene items. Every room offers enchanting views over the city, particularly the eighth and ninth floor open terraces which give our guests privacy. We do not have a common terrace due to our service concept. Every guest is special and unique for us, and they need individual spaces after busy business meetings.

What kind of services do you offer?

As our guests say, Citrus is a 4 star hotel offering the services



of a 5 star hotel. Our front desk is operational 24 hours a day, and our canteen always meets guest requirements. Breakfast in their rooms, diverse menus, desserts and room service make stays very comfortable. One ring to the front desk can ensure the most special requirements of a guest are met.

What is your contribution to tourism development?

The hotel is of average capacity, having only 36 rooms. Therefore we are constantly busy all year round. 3 conference halls provide an additional service, and as we focus on business they are in high demand. We promote both business and tourism development in the country.

We also develop new generations of workers, as we employ tourism specialists from state and

private universities. Hence, we pay our dividends to the education sector.

What are your future plans?

The hotel is continually developing, and keeps pace with modern standards through trainings. We are thinking of participating in international tourism exhibitions to build new networks, and also the international tourism awards.





Gudauri Inn

Affordable Prices and Comfortable Holidays

The Gudauri Inn Hotel opened in February 2017, having been constructed in just 6 months with an aid from the state project "Host in Georgia". It contains 60 rooms, both standard and deluxe, including triple and family units. It is 500 meters away from the main skiing track and cableways, while its advantageous location provides an enchanting view from every room.



The prices for double rooms start from as little as 30 USD per person, but some seasonal discounts are also available. Here Paata Kokaia, one of the founders of the hotel, tells us more about it.

How did you come to the idea of building Gudauri Inn?

The original idea was to build a hotel in Tbilisi that offered affordable prices. Hence, we built Iveria Inn, a 100-room hotel, available during the high season for 60 USD per double room, including meals. This hotel has been busy since day one, with a very high occupancy rate in both winter and summer.

However, when tourists come to Georgia they do not want to see Tbilisi only. They visit Kazbegi, Rabati, Batumi etc. So for the next destination we decided to build a hotel in Gudauri, a popular skiing resort and a close settlement to Kazbegi; after our visitors see Kazbegi they come to Gudauri for accommodation for a night. We began the construction in July and received our first guests in February. This hotel has been popular for both local and foreign tourists since its opening.

What principles did you follow when formulating the project?

First of all, we set out to employ locals wherever we could. I think a business should benefit the community around and the place it is in. Salary system is also very important, and we try to exceed the industry average. For example, our security personal's salary is 1,000 Gel. One of our core values is to improve the social conditions of the local people. Therefore we always try to employ local people whenever we can.

Thanks to our ethics and values, Gudauri Inn

enjoys high ratings and scores. It has also obtained tourists' trust.

How many tourists have you hosted?

So far the average occupancy rate was 70% per year, which is more than 15,000 room nights.

What sort of rooms do you have?

We have standard and deluxe type rooms and also triple and family rooms, or combinations of these. Every room has a beautiful view, and while close to the main road, we are located in peaceful surroundings. We have a veranda where our customers can enjoy their time. Some foreigners held their wedding parties there. We also have rooms adapted to people with disabilities.

What are your prices in any given season?

The prices for both Gudauri Inn and Iveria Inn are the same in the summer – 30 USD per person in a double room. The prices in Gudauri Inn increase to 100 USD per room in winter, as the ski season starts. However this price is fairly good for Gudauri and ski resorts in general. We also have a range of discounts available at all times.

We have quite high sales numbers due to our prices and quality.

What is your next goal?

We do not want to compete with other hotels over the existing customers. We want to attract more tourists from other countries. To do this we need to offer them attractive prices. This will help us compete with other touristic destinations on a country level. Tourists can spend two days with us in Tbilisi and then move to Gudauri, Bakuriani, Kakheti and/or Batumi... Georgia is a beautiful country and there is so much to see. We plan to expand our branch to other regions of Georgia. We want to employ local people and thus help the local economy.

We offer such affordable prices that I do not think other countries can compete. Our neighbors, Armenia and Azerbaijan, are attempting to take potential tourists from Georgia. For example, a new 800-room hotel has been built in Baku offering 50 USD per room. Even though it is very difficult to compete with such low prices we always try to adjust. There is so much potential for tourism in Georgia that we should keep doing well for the next many years to come.

There is also competition over attracting professional staff. When we started the business, it was rather difficult to find right people. We even had to hire English and Russian teachers, as knowledge of both languages is crucial in this industry. Then, some of our employees were taken away by other Brand hotels; we increased salaries, but it is still hard to retain good workers. We are doing the same in Gudauri, where we offer free trainings for the local people and give them certificates. There are lots of hotels in Gudauri, and as skilled workers are rare they take each other's staff. Nevertheless, we think it is important that private sector contributes to training fresh employee.

Can you expand on your other plans?

Our plans are quite ambitious. We have purchased land next to Iveria Inn and we are planning to add extra 100 rooms. This will make Iveria Inn the largest standard hotel in Georgia, with 200 rooms, conference halls, gym, saunas and hot tubs, but prices will stay the same. This will make our hotel a fascinating option for tourists, who will thus choose to come to Georgia.

Last year, the Ministry of Economy and Sustainable Development held an award ceremony.

Iveria Inn was named as the best standard hotel in Georgia, while Gudauri Inn was one of the finalists.


In addition to this we started a new project. Most of the houses in old Tbilisi are old and the living conditions are bad. We offer the residents to exchange their houses into newly build cozy apartments. If we manage to close a deal with all the residents in one building, we exchange the houses and then we restore that historical building and transform it into a classical hotel. This project will improve the living conditions of many. So far, we managed to close one deal and now we are building a new hotel on Agmashenebeli Avenue, while, most importantly, restoring the historical façade of the building.

We have begun construction of new 13 and 15 floor residential blocks on Godziashvili Street. These apartments will be equipped with aluminum doors and windows, German elevators, French ceilings, exteriors decorated with Georgian bricks and glass balconies. It is going to be a very beautiful residential apartment complex. These are the apartments we offer to the residents in old depreciated houses in Old Tbilisi area. They will get a fully refurbished apartment of European standards with exactly the same space as they had in the old building.

We also plan to open hotels in the other locations. These will certainly include Bakuriani, Batumi, Kakheti, and maybe Kutaisi. At 60 USD a night for two people, we can truly say that holidays in Georgia are both affordable and comfortable. Despite the low prices, tourists have high demands and we always try to meet their expectations.

Hotel Old Maidan

GT Interviewed GM of Hotel Old Maidan Shalva Alverdashvili

Can you tell us about the hotel: when and how did you decide to build it?

Hotel Old Maidan was founded 2 years ago in a historic building in Old Tbilisi, at the foot of Narikala Fortress at Vakhtang Gorgasali Square, 2 minutes from Shardeni and Kote Abpkazi Street (the former Leselidze Street). The old building has been renovated and equipped with modern security and fire protection systems.

What are its hotel priorities, and how does it differ from other hotels?

We are a boutique hotel. On the fourth floor there is a terrace with beautiful views of Old Tbilisi, at which breakfast is offered. The terrace makes breakfast particularly delightful. Guests may enjoy spectacular views of the River Mtkvari, the Narikala Fortress, ancient churches, colourful old carpets on sale and streets crammed with cafes and bars. They see how peacefully and lovingly different religions co-exist in Tbilisi, as the Georgian and Armenian churches, the Jewish synagogue, Zoroastrian shrines and Muslim mosques can be found in the same small area.

What is the style of the hotel?

The hotel is of ancient Tbilisi style. We preserve Tekla Batonishvili's palace gate, vintage items and old carpets. Our contemporary design is nevertheless harmonious with the style of Tbilisi and the city views. You will find working space, a mini-bar, a safe and personal hygiene items in the rooms of Old Maidan.

What sorts of rooms do you have?

There are 31 rooms of different categories at the hotel, including standard one bed and double bedrooms, semi-luxury and luxury rooms. There are rooms fully adapted to persons with disabilities. Some have balconies which are furnished with comfortable outdoor furniture. As I have already mentioned, everything guests might need can be found in their rooms.



Do you have any special offers or discounts?

Prices are fixed. Occasionally we offer our clients discounts during the low winter season. We also have special group and corporate tariffs for travel agencies and corporate customers.

What kind of services do you offer your customers?

Hotel Old Maidan enjoys quite a high guest satisfaction rating amongst boutique hotels. This is an indication of quality. Our 24 hour front desk is unusual for a 3 star hotel, and our room for people with disabilities and welcoming staff ensure we continue to provide high quality services. In our bar-restaurant you will enjoy cozy seating, Georgia-European cuisine, a wide choice of drinks and a pleasant atmosphere.

What is your contribution to the tourism sector?

The hotel has 31 rooms, so we cannot host large numbers of guests, but we are busy at every season. Our terrace has hosted wedding parties, birthday parties and small-scale events (maximum 40 persons). We also develop new generations of staff as we employ tourism graduates from state and private universities. The hotel also offers clients packages at the balneological resort, such as our healing, wellness, dermatological, gynecological/urological and "healthy spine" packages. In these ways we contribute to tourism, education and balneology development.

What are your future plans?

The hotel adopts modern standards and will keep training its staff to meet each new development. In the future we are hoping to participate in international tourist exhibitions and international awards.





Hotel Sno - Most of its income will be spent on the local population and rural development

Only a year old, Hotel Sno is situated in the village of Sno, in the ravine of the River Snostkali 5 km from Stepantsminda. It is in the grounds of the Catholicos-Patriarch's residence and was constructed through donations made to the Patriarchate to promote the employment of local residents and thus stem the migration of young people from the region. Most of its income will be spent on the local population and rural development.

The hotel consists of 34 rooms, - 29 standard, 2 deluxe and 3 presidential.

Sno is a legendary village with a great history. According to legend, Sno was an ancestor of the Gudushauri, who lived in a ravine in today's Kazbegi Region. Sno hosted Great King Vakhtang Gorgasali when he was on his way to fight the Lans, accompanied the king and gained fame in the battle. As a sign of gratitude, the king became his son Gudusha's godfather and thus a close relative. After that the village was named after Sno and the name Gudusha was transformed into a surname by his descendants.

Sno Castle was where the population of the ravine defended themselves from invaders. This castle was one of the main buildings in the ravine, and its defenders repeatedly drove back the enemy. Devotion to the motherland, loyalty to friends, courage and hospitality are still the main characteristics of the local residents today.

Almost all the villages in the ravine have changed, but Sno has maintained its original features. Narrow streets, foliage, stone and beautifully arranged fences and houses remind us of the past. You will see numerous holy places here. The amazing Holy Trinity Cathedral of Gergeti can be seen from every single part of the area, set against the high rocks.

As you know, Catholicos-Patriarch of Georgia Ilia II (Irakli Ghudushaur-Shiolashvili) was brought up in the village of Sno. His childhood home is situated near Sno Castle and his apartment is on the other side of the river. His grounds contain a beautiful church named after King Vakhtang Gorgasali, right by Hotel Sno.

The surrounding region is distinguished by its adventurous and exciting cultural tourism destinations. Cultural sights in the vicinity of the hotel include:





Holy Trinity Cathedral, Gergeti – This architectural complex is situated 6 km from Stepantsminda at 2,200 m above sea level. It consists of Holy Trinity Church and a bell tower built in the XVI century.

Gveleti waterfalls, which are only a few minutes from the hotel.

Dariali Ravine, which runs from the mouth of the River Chkheri to the River Larso. It is 11 km in length. Dariali Gorge, as the northern gate of the country, has always been of great strategic importance to Georgia.

Juta - One of the largest settlements in Kazbegi municipality, this is 30 minutes from the hotel. The famous Chaukhvi of Juta is located near the Caucasus at the River Bakhurev.

And finally there is **Trusos Ravine**, which contains many historical and cultural monuments. This ravine is rich in hydrocarbonated mineral waters, subalpine and alpine grasses and is just a few minutes from the hotel.
